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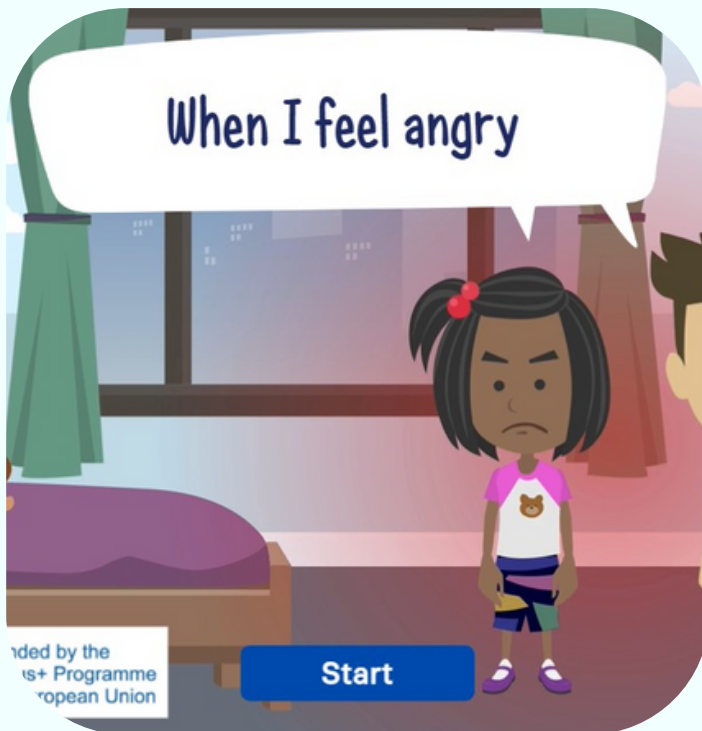
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Update of the interactive comics and the learning platform.

Our partners at Innovation Hive showed us the current status of both the educational platform and the interactive comics. The educational platform contains the courses in five different languages, within which you can find the interactive comics that will allow parents and caregivers to put the course contents into practice.

Digital video game status update

Our 'snakes and ladders' game is approaching its finalization, and it will be available both as a web-based game, as well as an Android application. Through the game, children with autism could play in pairs, or individually, and exercise their social skills through answering to scenarios that mirror real-life situations. Using the Teaching Interactive Procedure (TIP), children develop and enhance their skills, through interactive playing.



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The next training meeting of the TIPS project

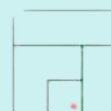
We will meet again soon, from November 1st to 2nd. This time we will be meeting in Larissa, Greece.



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
