Blue Firefly Multiplier Event

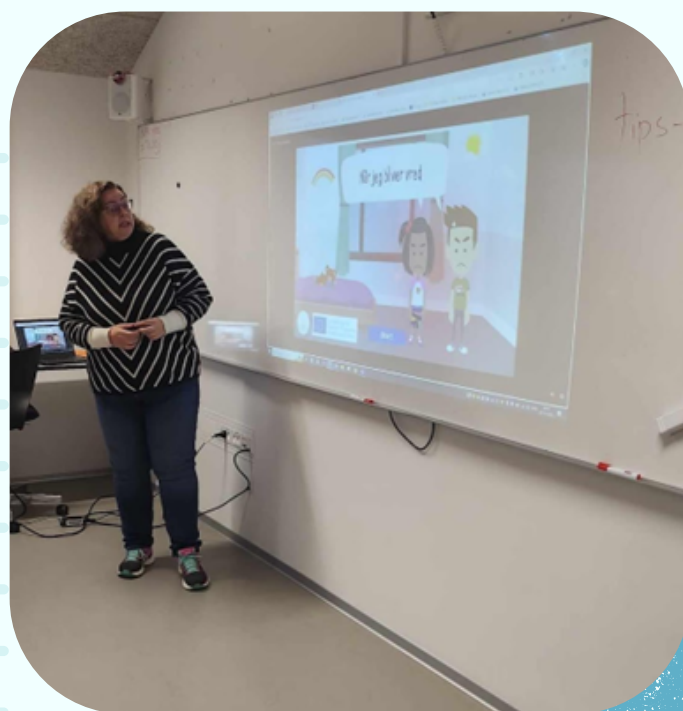
The event commenced with a detailed presentation of the project's core concepts and objectives, providing attendees with a comprehensive overview of the initiative's scope and significance.

Participants showed a keen interest to the project and its outputs. They were positive and digital tools were appreciated especially because digital materials could be used at home in their private them with their children.

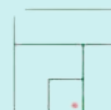
